DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of federal law in any manner inconsistent with its label. It is designed to dissolve quickly providing a steady source of available chlorine to control the growth of and destroy organic contaminants.

READ THE PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Adjust the pH of the spa or pool to between 7.2 and 7.6. The total alkalinity should be between 125 and 175 ppm. The chlorine level should be between 1.0 and 3.0 ppm in the spa or hot tub.

Add Spa Chlor-56 to spa at 1/2 oz. per 500 gallons of water. Add Spa Chlor-56 to pool at 1/2 oz. per 500 gallons of water. Add Spa Chlor-56 to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 - 3.0 ppm. Heavy bather chlorine residual.

Weekly, superchlorinate spa or pool with Spa Chlor-56 per 500 gallons.

Note: Draining and cleaning of spa or pool is recommended every 6 - 8 weeks. Do not mix with other chemicals. A dangerous reaction may occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a tightly closed container in a cool, dry, well ventilated area. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container thoroughly with water before discarding. Secure with several layers of newspaper or cardboard.
