DIRECTIONS FOR USE : It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

The Aqua Feeder™ Universal Feeder Cartridge has been designed to work in a wide variety of automatic swimming pool chlorinators. For best results consult and follow the instructions pertaining to the particular brand of chlorinator in use.

Adjust water pH to 7.2 - 7.6 as determined by a test kit. For pools with copper plumbing best pH factor is 7.6 - 7.8. If the pool has not been previously stabilized, add conditioner and stabilizer (cyanuric acid). Follow directions for use on the label for that product.

Please Note: The pH of Aqua Tabs® is on the acid side and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained at pH 7.2 - 7.6 as determined by a test, by periodic additions of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate. Superchlorinate swimming pool water at regular intervals to destroy accumulated organic wastes, algae, and bacteria. Use Aqua Shock™ or Aqua Burn® as directed for best results.

NOTE: For Guardex chlorinators, be sure to cut off the protruding air vent at the top of the feeder cartridge, then follow Guardex instructions as usual to maintain chlorine residual of 1-3 ppm.

For E-Z Chlor chlorinators, do not cut off air vent. Be sure to screw child resistant cap on tightly and follow E-Z Chlor instructions as usual to maintain chlorine residual of 1-3 ppm.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container in an open area if possible, and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose of in landfill area or bury in a safe place.
