Aqua Clear Alginate is the way to improve the appearance of your pool. It requires no special treating water and may be added to the water circulating in the pool or stored for long periods of time without loss of effectiveness or strength.

DIRECTIONS:

Use only in the manner inconsistent with the label.

Aqua Clear Alginate is effective against the growth of the following types of algae: Pyreoidosa (green algae), Phaeocystis (blue-green algae) and Phormidium.

For best results, pool should be treated by adding Aqua Clear Alginate to the circulating pool water. Allow the filter to run for 24 hours after adding algicide. During this time, the pool should not be allowed into the pool. Add Aqua Clear Alginate directly to pool water outside perimeter of pool.

Initial Application: (Original application not visible): Add one (1) quart per 20,000 gallons of pool water. Then use 2 quarts Aqua Clear Alginate per 20,000 gallons of pool water followed by 1 quart per 20,000 gallons of settled algae. Then add Aqua Clear Alginate immediately to pool water.

Continuing Application: Add Aqua Clear Alginate per 25,000 gallons of pool water three (3) to five (5) days.

Booster Applications: Add Aqua Clear Alginate per 25,000 gallons of pool water if bather load is heavy or after heavy rainfall.
