The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- Update Disposal Statements
- Update First Aid Statements
- Update Precautionary Statements
- Update Label Language
- Revise Confidential Statements of Formula
- Provide Child Resistant Packaging Certification

## Chemistry

The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for the Basic and an Alternate Formulation dated 6/27/02 are acceptable and will be made part of the record for this file.

### **Conditions**

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the statement on the front of the label to state: "Concentrated Formula Controls most Forms of Swimming Pool Algae" as the term "kills" is not appropriate for a swimming pool algae treatment product.

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- 2. Delete the statement: "It may be stored for long periods of time without losing its effectiveness or strength." This statement is vague and would be appropriate if it stated the shelf life of the product as supported by data.
- 3. Revise the paragraph in the "Directions for Use" section of the label which begins "For best results..." such that it is in compliance with PR Notice 2000-5. This notice discusses mandatory labeling language. Revise as follows: "Run the filter to circulate the pool water..." and "During this period, swimming is not permitted. Add..."
- 4. Revise the "Directions for Use" section of the label. Your application for pesticide indicates that this product is marketed in pint containers. Thus it is inappropriate for your label to state a dosage which is larger that the container size. Revise your label by deleting: Add one (1) quart per 20,000 gallons..." to state: "Add one (1) pint per 10,000 gallons..." and "If algae are visible, use two (2) quarts per 10,000 gallons..." to read "If algae are visible, use one (1) pint per 2500 gallons..."
- 5. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" section by deleting the "Container Disposal" heading which is unnecessary. In addition revise to state: "...Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated locked area. Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash."
- 6. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to read: "Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."
- 7. Revise the "First Aid" statements such they are in agreement with PR Notice 2001-1 by including the following statement: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."
- 8. Since this product is being marketed in containers no larger than 1 gallon, delete the "Environmental Hazards" statement for containers equal to or greater than 5 gallons. If you are marketing this product in other container sizes, please advise the Agency so that the appropriate corrections can be made to the label.

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit (2) copies of the final printed labeling before distributing or selling this product bearing the revised labeling.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with precautionary statements and directions.

[Aqua Clear Alginate] {or} [This product] is effective in controlling the growth of the following types of algae: Chlorella pyrenoidosa (green algae), Phormidium inundatum (blue-green algae) and Phormidium ritzii.

For best results, the pool should be free of algae before adding [Aqua Clear Alginate] {or} [this product]. The filter should be circulating the pool water when adding this algaecide. Allow the filter to run for at least six (6) hours after adding algaecide. During this period, swimmers should not be allowed into the water. Add [Aqua Clear Alginate] {or} [this product] directly to pool by pouring around entire outside perimeter of pool.

Initial Application: (Original filling or when algae are not visible): Add one (1) quart of [Aqua Clear Alginate] {or} [this product] per 20,000 gallons of pool water. If algae are visible, use two (2) quarts of [Aqua Clear Alginate] {or} [this product] per 10,000 gallons of pool water followed by cleaning out of dead, settled algae.
