Its long lasting action controls existing algae and maintenance dosages will control algae regrowth. This algacide will not cause the water to foam and will not alter the pH or chlorine of the water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner that is inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL DOSE: Apply by pouring directly into the pool water, 7 ounces of **Broad Spectrum Algacide** per 10,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof.

MAINTENANCE DOSAGE: 3 1/2 ounces of **Broad Spectrum Algacide** should be poured directly into the pool for every 10,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling the pool at the beginning of the swimming season. If the pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dosage. Vacuum after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If algae are still visible or reappear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at two week intervals. If high temperatures prevail or the pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.
