It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Aqua Clear Winter Algaecide controls the growth of the following types of algae: *Scenedesmus pyreoidosa* (green algae), *Microcystis* (blue-green algae) and Phormidium.

For best results, pool water should be circulated before adding Aqua Clear Winter Algaecide. Cover pool with solid or close mesh cover to prevent debris from accumulating in the pool.

Add Aqua Clear Winter Algaecide to 1 gallon of Aqua Clear Winter Algaecide per 50,000 gallons of pool water by pouring around the perimeter of the pool. This will control algae growth over the winter and in the spring.

Add Aqua Clear Winter Algaecide to the pool. Make sure that the pool water at the bottom of the pool is treated with the algaecide...allow filter to run for 24 hours after adding algaecide.

To reopen the pool in the spring, run up filter and add 10% Algaecide (1 gallon per 50,000 gallons of pool water ingredient). If algae are visible, add 10% Algaecide (1 gallon per 50,000 gallons of pool water ingredient), followed by clear water immediately. When water is clear, resume daily pool operation.
