Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. Refer to the enclosed Attachment A for the necessary revisions to the Precautionary Statements for the subject product.
2. Delete "& related compounds" from the ingredient statement.
3. Under the directions for swimming pool/spa use include the statement "Re-entry into treated pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine".

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. This product is designed to dissolve quickly and provide a steady source of available chlorine to control the growth of algae and to destroy organic contaminants.

READ THE PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Adjust the pH of the pool water to 7.2-7.8 as determined by a pH test kit. In new pools (pools of fresh water), add chlorine granules at a rate of one pound per 5,000 gallons of water. A chlorine stabilizer will maintain a level of approximately 1.0 ppm. Extra-Gran will provide a chlorine makeup.

Before initiating daily chlorine (shock treat) the pool water should be adjusted to a pH of 7.2-7.8 by using an appropriate pH adjuster. Reacted on the product label. Use of a suitable chlorine test kit is essential to return to the proper pH. Determined by a suitable test kit.

For daily use, add Rapid-Chlor 1.0 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Chlor through the pool skimmer with a chlorine test kit, and a chlorine stabilizer will be needed to maintain a level of 1.5 and 1.0 ppm.

During especially hot periods, superchlorinate the pool as directed above. Failure to superchlorinate will result in growth of pool water algae. In pool, use a concentrated chlorine product label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a tightly closed container in a cool, dry, well ventilated area. Do not use in a fire. Do not reuse empty container thoroughly washed before discarding. Several layers of newspaper should be used to wrap the container.

2. The Precautionary Statements should read:

"Corrosive: Cause irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust, vapor or spray mist. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse".

3. The Statements of Practical Treatment should read:

"If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention".

"If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention".

"If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists".

"If swallowed: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Get medical attention".
