GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Alstar Liquid Algaecide
in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs of minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs with heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use.

For pools having just visible algae growth add a fluid ounce of Alstar Liquid Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools with heavy growth of algae move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 10 to 18 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Alstar Liquid Algaecide per 10,000 gallons should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 3 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially Alstar Liquid Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of 0.4 to 1 fluid ounces of Alstar Liquid Algaecide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Alstar Liquid Algaecide is commonly used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains with an alkaline pH. Alstar Liquid Algaecide is not used on decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals. Chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
