

**FIRST AID:** If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

For use in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, hot tubs, that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness use in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae. Use by using PDQ 10.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of PDQ 10 fluid ounces of PDQ 10 to remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of algae add initially 4 to 7.5 fluid ounces of PDQ 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 PDQ 10 per 10,000 gallons of water every 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with algae growth require an initial dose of 8 PDQ 10 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 PDQ 10 should be made for maintenance.

PDQ 10 will provide effective control of algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools not treated during the swimming season and are free of algae should be treated with 6.5 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons. Season pools with some visible algae growth, add 1 PDQ 10 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. Repeat the treatment one or more times if necessary.

PDQ 10 is compatible with chlorine products and is effective against algae. PDQ 10 can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix PDQ 10 with other chlorine products.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Labeling should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of contents and container as directed.
