

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner not specified on the label.

PDQ 60 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness, use PDQ 60 to using PDQ 60.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of PDQ 60 fluid ounces of PDQ 60 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 fluid ounces of PDQ 60 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing algae growth require an initial dose of 1 fluid ounce of PDQ 60 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 fluid ounces of PDQ 60 should be made 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

PDQ 60 will provide effective control of algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools that are not regularly treated during the swimming season and are free of algae should be treated with 10 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add 1 fluid ounce of PDQ 60 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of PDQ 60 in the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. It may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

PDQ 60 is competitive with other algicides used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. PDQ 60 can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix PDQ 60 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wipe up any spilled material.
