### FOR POOLS AND SPAS TREATED WITH CHLORINE OR BROMINE:

STEP 1: Drain pool to desired level.

STEP 2: Add 2 pounds *Pool Stain Treat*® per 20,000 gallons of pool or spa water.

STEP 3: Add 1 quart Winter Treat® per 20,000 gallons water.

STEP 4: Add 4 pounds of granular, fast dissolving dichloro-s-triazinetrione <u>or</u> 8 pounds lithium hypochlorite <u>or</u> 4 gallons of liquid sodium hypochlorite (pool bleach) <u>or</u> 4 pounds of bromine per 20,000 gallons water.
