FOR CRYSTAL CLEAR WATER WHEN OPENING AND STARTING FOR THE SEASON POOLS AND SPAS TREATED WITH CHLORINE OR BROMINE:

- STEP 1: Add 32 fluid ounces of Spring Treat® per 15,000 gallons of pool or spa water.
- STEP 2: Add 2 lbs of dry granular chlorine or 2 gallons of liquid chlorine per 15,000 gallons of water.
- STEP 3: Wait 1 hour before entering pool or spa. Observe the required waiting period for the chlorine or bromine product used with Spring Treat® if greater than 1 hour.
