- 1. Within the If swallowed statement, in the First Aid Section, replace "Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow" with "Do not give any liquid to the person."
- 2. Please note that the following statement is recommended to appear below the First Aid Section:" Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."
- 3. Replace "thandlers" with "handlers".
- 4. Relocate the statement "Do not contaminate water, foodstuffs, feed or seed by storage or disposai" so that it appears directly beneath the storage and disposal heading.
- 5. Relocate the warranty statement so that it appears either before or after the Directions for Use.
- 6. Change the "Precautions" heading to read "Precautions and Restrictions".

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS


