HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Swallowing: Call a Physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration. Indicated.

Keep children and pets off treated areas before spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE, continued

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

IN FOGGING EQUIPMENT AND HAND SPRAYERS

Fleas, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths: Close room and discharge mist vigorously in all parts of room using 1 - 1 1/2 to 2 ounces for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Leave room closed for at least ten minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

IN PRESSURIZED TANK SPRAYERS FOR WETTING

CONTACT SPRAYS

Fleas (Infesting Premises): Remove and destroy animal's bedding and spray the sleeping quarters freely, forcing the spray into cracks in the floor and about the room. Repeat when re-infested.

Roaches, Waterbugs: Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and waterbugs infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat the operation as often as necessary.

Clothes Moths, Carpet Beets: protected, giving particular seams. For carpet beetles, lift sides and edges of carpet on boards and under furniture storage containers such as should be sprayed regularly, repeated every 30 days unless in airtight containers.

Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Rust Red Flour Beetles, Cigarettes, Grain Mill Cigarette Beetles and Drug Store Weevils: Treat all areas for weevils and other pests. This material is 1,000 square feet of floor of floor when
