Number One

For use in homes, hotels, motels, schools, hospitals, restaurants, and other areas where food is prepared or served. Mix 20 ml of concentrate with 1 liter of water. Spray thoroughly.

Number Three

For use in homes, hotels, motels, schools, hospitals, restaurants, and other areas where food is prepared or served. Mix 40 ml of concentrate with 1 liter of water. Spray thoroughly.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Diazinon is an insecticide used to control household insects. It is effective against cockroaches, ants, silverfish, and other household pests. It is also used in agriculture and industry. Note: The quantity of Diazinon used should be based on the amount of surface to be treated. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or served. Carpet Beetles: Apply a wet Diazinon spray to the edges of carpet boards and edges of carpet. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or served.

Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants and Silverfish - Mix 1/2 ounce of concentrate with 1 quart of water. Spray thoroughly on the surface to be treated. Repeat every 7 to 10 days until the infestation is under control.

Carpet Beetles - Apply 1/2 ounce of concentrate to 1 quart of water. Spray thoroughly on the surface to be treated. Repeat every 7 to 10 days until the infestation is under control.

Spiders and Scorpions - Apply 1/2 ounce of concentrate to 1 quart of water. Spray thoroughly on the surface to be treated. Repeat every 7 to 10 days until the infestation is under control.

Pantry Pests - exposed stages (Saw-toothed Grain Beetle, Flour Beetle, Rice Weevil, Cigarette Beetle, Drugstore Beetle, Indian Meal Moth, etc.) - Mix 1/2 ounce of concentrate with 1 quart of water. Spray thoroughly on the surface to be treated. Repeat every 7 to 10 days until the infestation is under control.

Brown Dog Ticks in Buildings - Mix 1/2 ounce of concentrate with 1 quart of water. Spray thoroughly on the surface to be treated. Repeat every 7 to 10 days until the infestation is under control.
