How to Mix and Apply

Step #1. Determine size of spraying job. For lawns and vegetables measure the area to be sprayed. For all other applications, apply at a thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear. Repeat applications as needed as stated in the rate chart.

Step #2. Use clean sprayer. Carefully measure and mix the amount of DIAZINON 2E INSECT SPRAY and water as suggested in the rate chart.

Step #3. Spray as directed in rate chart. Use coarse droplets spray for lawns, soil and other surface applications. Use medium fine mist sprays for trees and plants. Thorough coverage is important. Follow up with clean water after each use.

Use contents within 6 months after opening.

WARNING

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
