DILUTE THIS PRODUCT WITH FUEL OIL OR KEROSENE AT THE RATE OF ONE PART CONCENTRATE TO 8 PARTS OIL TO OBTAIN THE READY TO USE SPRAY.

PYRONOX O.C. 1.2 IS DESIGNED FOR CONTROL OF SMALL FLYING INSECTS- FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES, DROSOPHILA GNATS, (VINEGAR AND FRUIT FLIES), BLOW FLIES, AND AIDS IN THE CONTROL OF EXPOSED STAGES OF SMALL FLYING MOTHS - ANGLIMOIS GRAIN MOTHS, MEDITERRANEAN FLOUR MOTH, AND INDIAN MEAL MOTHS. WHEN FOGGING OR SPACE SPRAY SPRAYING WITH THIS PRODUCT, APPLY AT THE RATE OF 100, PER 1000 CU. FT SPACE SPRAY INTO ENTIRE ROOM, AFTER CLOSING OFF ALL AIR CURRENT, SPRAY SHOULD BE DIRECTED UPWARD AT WALL AND CEILINGS SO THAT AS MANY INSECTS AS POSSIBLE CAN BE CONTACTED WITH A DIRECT VAPOR OR MIST. ROOM SHOULD BE CLOSED AT LEAST TEN MINUTES AFTER SPRAYING. REPEAT AS OFTEN AS NECESSARY TO KEEP NAMED INSECTS UNDER CONTROL. PERIODIC SPRAYING OF PYRONOX O.C. 1.2 ASSISTS IN THE CONTROL OF NEW INFESTATIONS OF NAMED INSECTS. SWEEP UP ALL DEAD AND DYING INSECTS AND DESTROY THEM AT THE CLOSE OF THE 10 MIN. PERIOD.

PYRONOX O.C. 1.2 IS DESIGNED FOR CONTROL OF CRAWLING INSECTS- AMERICAN, GERMAN, AND ORIENTAL COCK ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH AND AIDS IN THE CONTROL OF EXPOSED STAGES OF STORED PRODUCT PESTS- CONFUS FLOUR BEETLES, RED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE BEETLES, CASELLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, DRUG STORE BEETLES, CIGARETTE BEETLES, AND CARPET BEETLES. THOROUGHLY CLEAN ALL FLOUR, GRAIN, AND FOOD DUSTS FROM HORIZONTAL SURFACES, SINCE THESE STATIC ACCUMULATIONS ENCOURAGE STORED PRODUCT PEST BREEDING. SPRAY OUTSIDE OF STORAGE BAGS BEFORE STORING. SPRAY BOX CARS AND STORE ROOMS BEFORE FILLING WITH GRAIN FEED OR FOOD PRODUCTS. REPEAT AT REGULAR INTERVALS OR AS OFTEN AS NECESSARY TO CONTROL THE NAMED INSECTS.
