The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1. For products 45385-42, add the following statement to the "PHYSICAL HAZARDS" section:

"Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard."

- 2. For product 45385-81, remove "picnic areas" from the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE, APPLICATION" section. If "picnic areas" is not removed, the product must be labeled as a RESTRICTED USE product.
- 3. For reg. number 45385-42, revise the fourth sentence under "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" to read "Do not apply in meat packing plants, bakeries, or other food processing plants while facilities are in operation."

Before spraying in hospitals, remove
patients. After spraying, ventilate area for
hours before returning patients.

GENERAL: This concentrate is designed for use
in sprayers which give particle sizes of aerosol size.

SPACE SPRAY: Use undiluted in aerosol generator
to treat roaches, flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, and
other insects on exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room
and turn off conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of
1 ounce concentrate per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct output
upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave for
1 hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entering. R
