

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
 Hazards to Humans

CAUTION

OUTDOORS AND INDOORS FOR ORNAMENTAL PLANTS — To kill aphids, climbing cutworms, Japanese beetles, leafhopper nymphs, red spider mites, thrips and whiteflies on certain ornamentals such as roses, gladiola, azalea, chrysanthemum, and on house plants. Spray shrubs, bushes and grassy areas while moving away from area. Spray with the breeze, allowing mist to drift into shrubbery and other places. As an area spray, mist porches, patios, picnic areas. Repeat as necessary. Avoid wetting — a light spray kills bugs effectively. Spray plants in short bursts only and when the temperature is below 90°F. Repeat as necessary in 7 day intervals. Use caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray on food crops.
