Dilute one gallon of Wik-Rub with four gallons of kerosene.

To repel HORN FLIES, STABLE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, LICE, FLEAS AND GNATS, fill the back-rubber and facerubber applicators with the diluted mixture of Wik-Rub insecticide. It will take a few minutes for the canvas parts to become saturated.

The applicators should be placed where the livestock loaf or congregate so that they may have access to it at all times. Repeated applications will build up repellency in those areas of the animal treated with the insecticide repellent.
