

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapor. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. FIRST AID

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. DO not contaminate feed, water, or mineral supplements with this compound. Do not contaminate milk or milk handling equipment. Wash udder and teats before milking. This product is not for use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas.

For use, dilute one gallon of WIK-RUB Insecticide Concentrate with four (4) gallons of kerosene.

To control HORN FLIES and STABLE FLIES fill the back-rubber and facerubber applicators with the diluted mixture of WIK-Rub insecticide. It will take a few minutes for the canvas, burlap or other absorbent parts to become saturated.

The applicators should be placed where the livestock loaf or congregate so that they may have access to it at all times during fly season.

Clean and recharge the applicators (depending on time and heavy animal use), with additional WIK-RUB diluted mixture as needed to continue good insecticidal fly control activity.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Avoid storage conditions that might alter the composition or usefulness of the pesticide, e.g., temperature extremes, excessive moisture, or humidity, sunlight, friction, or contaminating substances or media. Keep pesticide container closed in a cool, dry, locked cabinet or room.
