Subject: Updated First Aid Statements Chem-Tox Malathion 3 EPA Reg. No. 45385-65 Your Application Dated April 5, 2004

The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you submit two copies of your final printed label incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.

1. If, as indicated in your letter of March 21, 2003, the product is not intended for household use, remove the household container disposal instructions.

2. Since the added restriction for aerial use in Florida is not a Federal restriction, the label should be revised by removing the State restriction and replacing it with the statement cited below. This general statement would not only direct the user to consult with the proper regulatory agency in Florida but in other States or tribal areas as well. This general statement is also more in line with the wording being proposed in the draft PR Notice for adult mosquito control products dated April 28, 2004. This draft document may be found on the Agency's website at www.epa.gov/PR_Notices.

Before applying the product for mosquito control, consult with the State or tribal agency with primary responsibility for pesticide regulation to determine if other regulatory requirements exist.

If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of this condition.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of the Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR FLY CONTROL: OUTSIDE OF FARM **BUILDINGS AND DAIRY BARNS:**

Apply at the rate of one (1) gallon per 1,000 sq. ft. on painted surfaces and two (2) gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. on unpainted surfaces where flies alight or congregate, window sills, fences, etc. Use a large droplet spray that wets all surfaces to the point of run off. Repeat as necessary.

GENERAL OUTDOOR TREATMENT: For BITING MIDGES (adults), FLIES (adults), GNATS

(adults), MOSQUITOES (adults), MOTHS (adults): Apply 1/2 gallon (64 fluid ounces) of MALATHION 3 per acre as a fog, aerosol, or space spray, average swath width is 300 to 400 feet. For MOSQUITOES, allow the spray to remain in the area for a minimum of 10 seconds. For FLIES, allow spray to remain in the area for a minimum of 40 to 50 seconds.

MOSQUITO CONTROL DIRECTIONS FOR THERMAL FOGGING

Apply at the rate of 1 gallon per 2 acres. For maximum effectiveness outdoor fogging should be carried out only under surface conditions which usually exist only from one hour after sunset. through the night, and until sunrise. During this time, providing the wind velocity is under 3-4 miles per hour, the fog will remain in the area and close to the ground the required time to be fully effective. Outdoor fogging, in windy (over 4 mph) weather will be ineffective as the tiny fog particles will be too widely dispersed by the wind. Repeat as necessary.

AIRPLANE APPLICATION

Apply insecticide at a rate of 2 1/2 gallons per acre. PROHIBITION ON AERIAL USE IN FLORIDA: Not for aerial application in the State of Florida unless specifically authorized by the Florida Bureau of Entomology and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, (04-05-04)
