

FLYING INSECTS: Use CENOL MILL SPRAY for control of flying insects. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should also be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. After space spraying in food processing plants, thoroughly wash all equipment, benches, shelving etc. where exposed food will be handled, with an effective cleaning compound with potable water. When using this product as a space spray, apply only when plant is not in operation. Before spraying, close all doors and windows in the area to be treated, to prevent drift of fog or spray.
