Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area.

PESTS TO BE DISPOSED: Empty containers (1 Gallon) of this concentrate resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: For Containers 1 Gallon and Under: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

For Containers Over 1 Gallon: Empty container (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning or purchase and use as a sanitary landfill, or by other available means approved by State and Federal authorities.

DILUTING INSTRUCTIONS

Dilute to 0.04% SBP-1382 by adding 1 fl. oz. of the concentrate to 4 fl. oz. of petroleum distillate.

Dilute to 0.25% SBP-1382 by adding 1 fl. oz. of the concentrate to 14 fl. oz. of petroleum distillate.

Dilute to 0.25% SBP-1382 by adding 1 fl. oz. of the concentrate to 14 fl. oz. of petroleum distillate.

Dilute to 0.10% SBP-1382 (which can be used for flying insects only) by adding 1 fl. oz. of the concentrate to 29 fl. oz. of petroleum distillate.

FOR USE IN ULV, MECHANICAL AEROSOL GENERATORS SUCH AS THE VECO MINI ULV OR MICRO GEN: Apply undiluted at a rate of 0.5 fl. oz. or 12.8 ml of concentrate per 1,000 cu. ft. (28.3 l.) of treated space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Exhaust all fumes in the area to be treated. Shut off all air conditioning or ventilation equipment. Vacate room before application. Leave closed for one hour after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before entry.

SPACE SPRAY: To kill and/or protect stages of house flies, house flies, gnats, mosquitoes, and small flying moths. Treat as a space spray, directing output toward upper corners of room and ceiling.

TO KILL HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Treat as a space spray, directing output toward upper corners of room and ceiling.

CONTACT SPRAY: Use to control house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, spiders, fleas, crickets, centipedes, cockroaches, silverfish, and other insects. Apply the spray as a contact spray into cracks, crevices, in woodwork, walls, floors, beneath sinks and other areas where insects contact as many insects as possible.

FOR HORSE STABLES: Not for application to horses or other animals.

FOR MECHANICAL MISTING EQUIPMENT SUCH AS THE MICAULS CHALLENGER MACHINES: For most effective results, use the following instructions: Operate Spraying Dispenser adjusted to deliver a fine mist. For most insects, use dilute: 0.10% or 0.25% SBP-1382.

TO KILL HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows. Turn nozzle upward, direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 30 minutes. Ventilate the room before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS: Adjust spray to produce a fine mist. Apply to cracks and crevices and use either 0.25% or 0.10% SBP-1382.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, EARWIGS, GRASSHOPPERS, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, FLEAS, CENTIPEDES AND OTHER INSECTS: Adult and accessible stages of cockroaches, earwigs, grasshoppers, crickets, silverfish, and accessible stages of centipedes may be controlled by spraying so as to contact them. Spiders, fleas, and centipedes may be controlled by spraying in cracks and crevices. Antrium is a term for the most effective flying insects. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapor. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wear mask or respirator if type recommended by NIOSH to give adequate protection against this material. Wear protective clothing. Wash exposed skin with soap and water after handling and after eating. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and water separately from other clothing before reuse.
