

FOR APPLICATION OUTDOORS AND INDOORS.

For Insect Control on Outdoor Ornamental Plants. Hobby Greenhouses Plants, and on House Plants.

### **OUTDOORS:**

To kill APHIDS, CLIMBING CUTWORMS, JAPANESE BEETLES, LEAF HOPPER nymphs, RED SPIDER MITES, THRIPS, and WHITE FLIES on certain ornamentals such as: Roses, Gladiolas, Azaleas Chrysanthemums, and on house plants. Spray shrubs, bushes and grassy areas while moving away from the area. Spray with the breeze, allowing mist to drift into shubbery and other places. As an area spray mist porches and patios. Repeat as necessary. Avoid a "wetting" spray since a light spray mist kills bugs effectively. Spray plants in short bursts only and when the temperature is below 85° F. Repeat as necessary in 7 days intervals. Use spray mist "sparingly" on young and new plant growth. Do not spray on food crops.

## INDOORS:

### FOR HOME "HOBBY GREENHOUSE," AND "HOUSE PLANT", INSECTS

For infestations of white flies, aphids, spider mites, thrips and leafhoppers on Ageratum, aster, Azalea, begonia, Calendula, Chrysanthemums, Coleus, Fuchsia, Geraniums, Ivy, Marigold, Salvia, Petunia, Poinsettia, and Roses. This product is ready-to-use.

USE AS A SPRAY-MIST CONTACT SPRAY: For control of these insects select a suitable Pressure or Hand Trigger Sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine spray mist. Apply a light mist to contact the upper and lower surfaces of plant foliage to point of runoff. Treat in late afternoon and evening when the temperatures are moderate such as 50° F to 70° F. Repeat application weekly for four weeks or longer for control of <u>adults, pupae, and nymphs.</u> Complete the spray schedule on Poinsettia before "blooms" form. When control is obtained and fewer applications are preferred, repeat as needed.

To kill House flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Flying moths (Millers), and Fruit Flies; Select a suitable pressure or hand pump sprayer adjusted to produce a fine fog type "spray mist". Close all doors and windows. Keep sprayer nozzle 2 feet from indoor sur-

doors and windows. Keep sprayer nozzle 2 feet from indoor surfaces. Pointing spray nozzle upward to fill the room with the mist. Leave the treated area closed at least 15 minutes. Ventilate room when finished. Sweep up and dispose of dead insects.

To kill Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Spiders, and Ants: Adjust sprayer to produce larger wetting droplets to spray directly on insects when possible. Spray thoroughly, baseboards, cracks, crevices, and in back of, and under, appliances, sinks; and cupboards the specific of the composition of the comp where these pests have harborages. For Spiders: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders. To kill Ants, spray doors, around window frames, ant trails and hills.
