

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans
and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is antidote of choice.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED — Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED — Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN — Wash contaminated skin with soap and water. **IF IN EYES** — Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried.

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.
Do Not Store Below 32 Degrees F.

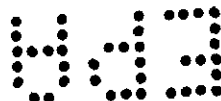

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL—HOUSEHOLD: Do not reuse empty container (bottle, can, bucket). Wrap container and put in trash collection.

METAL — 5, 30 AND 55 GALS. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

General: Use Residual Spray from D TRAITS Intermediate 2247 as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. To control the source of your flea infestation, treat pets with a product registered for animal application.

For Crack & Crevice: Application within Food Handling Establishments (places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served) including but not limited to restaurants, grocery stores, bakeries, bottling plants, canneries and grain mills. To kill ants, roaches, crickets, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders, earwigs, brown dog ticks, fleas, carpet beetles and dermestids. Apply diluted in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product on exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE AND SPOT TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Fleas and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an antiseptic reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under leaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Ticks and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

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
