### Precautionary Statements

#### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

### CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed. Inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and avoid adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is drug of choice.

Do not apply directly to food or to commercial food handling facilities. Cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. In homes, a food processing surface and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED**—Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if stomach was taken into mouth. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING** unless on treatment of a known poison. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If symptoms persist, give vomit. If not, give two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat to repeat vomiting. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to a person in serious condition.

**IF INHALED**—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply first aid as indicated.

**IF ON SKIN**—Wash with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES**—Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

Remove pets, birds and other fish and animals from treated area. Do not allow children or pets in contact with treated surfaces until spray has dried.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**General:** Use Ready Spray from D-TRAP<sup>®</sup> Inter-late date 2347 at a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to treated areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

#### FOR SPOT TREATMENT

**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, ceiling, baseboards, under and behind wall papers, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to trails and nest entrances and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as carpet and dressing room, hallway, cracks and crevices, along and behind handrails, window and door frames and localized areas of carpet and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Thoroughly spray the entire room, furniture and walls and then vacuuming in treatment. **Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.** See label for complete information and instructions with use of traps and other animal applications.

**For Crack & Crevices:** Apply with D-Trap Handling a special application brush or other suitable device. Wash out ticks and fleas from carpeted or serried rooms but not treated floors, furniture, drapery, stoves, bakeries, cutting plants, lawns and gardens. To kill ants, roaches, beetles, silverfish, ticks and sowbugs, brown dog ticks, head, carpet beetles and termites. Apply diluted in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a fine mist should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to closets, hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above insects or pests hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing this product into equipment or process producing the material to be treated. Avoid contact with food or food processing surfaces.

**Flees and Mosquitoes:** Use only out of doors as an air repellent and a nuisance from these insects. Also spray dark corners and favorite resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. **HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS. (10 pt)**

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not linger in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Do not apply as a space spray while food processing is underway. Except in federally inspected meat and poultry plants, when applied as a surface spray with care in accordance with the directions and precautions given above, food processing operations may continue. Foods should be removed or covered before treatment. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. **DOMESTIC DWELLINGS - OUTDOORS:** **ANTS** (including fire ants), **BROWN DOG TICK**, **CLOVER MITE**, **COCKROACHES**, **CRICKETS**, **EARWIGS**, **FLEAS**, **MILLIPEDES**, **SOBBUGS:** Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where pests may enter. For **ANTS**, spray hills and runways. Repeat as needed. Do not spray vegetation.

**CAT/DOG SLEEPING QUARTERS AND KENNELS:** **BROWN DOG TICK**, **FLEAS**, **LONE STAR TICK:** Animal premise treatment. Keep nozzle 1 to 1.5 feet from surfaces when spraying. Remove and destroy pets' old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, walls, cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Put fresh bedding in pets' quarters after spray has dried. For kennels, apply to outside runways, window ledge and sills. For **FLIES** and **MOSQUITOES** to reduce annoyance, spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where pests may enter premises.

Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches and patios where pests congregate. **INDOORS:** For **ANTS**, **CENTIPEDES**, **CLOVER MITE**, **COCKROACHES**, **CRICKETS**, **EARWIGS**, **FIREBRATS**, **FLEAS**, **GRAIN MITE**, **MILLIPEDES**, **SILVERFISH**, **SOBBUGS**, **SPIDERS** (including black widow spider) **STORED PRODUCT INSECTS**, **TICKS:** Spray directly on insects wherever possible and in areas where pests may be found: such as in carpets, under sinks, firewood piles, drainboards, cabinets, cracks and crevices on baseboards, pipes, around screens, garbage cans, refuse areas in attics, behind shelving, bookcases, storage areas and other areas where pests may be found. Repeat as needed. For **ANTS**, spray hills, and trails over window and door sills. For **STORED PRODUCT INSECTS** and **GRAIN MITE**, find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. For **SPIDERS**, spray webbing. To kill **BEEES**, **HORNETS**, **WASPS**, **YELLOWJACKETS**, apply in the late evening when pests are at rest. Apply liberally to hiding and breeding places, especially

under rafters, contacting as many pests as possible. Repeat as needed. For BEDBUGS and LICE, spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take the bed apart and seams. Take the bed apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. Allow treated fabric to dry thoroughly before use.

COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL and INSTITUTIONAL AREAS, EATING ESTABLISHMENTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS - EDIBLE: Indoor spot treatment. For ANTS BROWN DOG TICK, CARPET BEETLES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, DERMESTID BEETLES, EARWIGS, FLEAS, GRAIN MITE, SILVERFISH, SOUBUGS, SPIDERS, STORED PRODUCT INSECTS, apply around baseboards, behind, and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For GRAIN MITE and STORED PRODUCT INSECTS, find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from the pantry. Spray the shelves to kill pests present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return the packages after the shelves have dried. Repeat as needed.

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
