

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact see FIRST AID. Do not use in commercial food processing; food preparation, food storage, or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatments or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be removed or covered. Remove pets, and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. When used in a hospital remove patients before treating room. Thoroughly ventilate the area for 2 hours before returning patients.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED - Immediately call a Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give ANY liquid to the person.

Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
IF IN EYES - Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not for use on animals.

FOR KENNELS AND PET ANIMAL QUARTERS

To control Fleas, and Ticks use as a contact spray treatment with the spray nozzle adjusted to a fine droplet. Contact as many insects as possible in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the area suspected of harboring the pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks and crevices wherever the pests are suspected of hiding. Remove and destroy, (or spray and thoroughly clean), old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried.

Do not spray animals with this product. Treat dogs or cats with an EPA registered "Flea and Tick Control" product, for that use, before allowing them to return to the treated quarters. If needed, repeat spray treatments in the same manner.

USE AS A SPACE SPRAY TREATMENT

FOR AREAS AS LISTED ON THE FRONT PANEL; DOMESTIC DWELLINGS, COMMERCIAL and INDUSTRIAL and INSTITUTIONAL AREAS, (NON-FOOD AREAS), RAILROAD CARS, and TRUCK TRAILERS: To control: Bees, Flies, Flying Moths, Gnats, House flies, Mosquitoes, and Wasps, use as a "Space Spray" treatment with equipment adjusted to produce a fine fog mist. Close room, warehouse or other area to be treated and shut off all ventilating systems. Dispense product as a fine fogging mist. Do not remain in treated area. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Thoroughly aerate after treatment is completed, (5 to 10 minutes). Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

USE AS A CONTACT SPRAY TREATMENT

For Ants, Brown dog ticks, Carpet beetles, Cockroaches, Confused flour beetles, Crickets, Firebrats, Fleas, Rice weevil, Sawtoothed grain beetles, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Ticks, and Waterbugs, use as a contact residual spray treatment with equipment adjusted to produce fine, wetting spray droplets to contact as many insects as possible in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring the pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks and hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves, and refrigerators and wherever the pests are suspected of hiding. Repeat as necessary.

Also for Ant control treat doors, around window frames; ant trails and other areas of entry. For Carpet Beetle control, spray both the interior and exterior of upholstered furniture and also spray the top and bottom of rugs and carpets. Spray shelves, closets, areas under furniture, and wherever insects are seen or suspected. For control of exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, and Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, find and destroy infested package foods. Remove all other pantry items. Spray shelves to kill any insects present. Remove dead insects and destroy, clean shelves, and replace with new shelf paper after surfaces are dry.
