Dear Mr. Baker:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Under the Precautionary Statements section, delete the phrase "See FIRST AID". Move the statements "Remove pets, birds, and cover fish...has dried." to the Directions for Use section of the label. Add the following statement to this section "Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."
2. Under the First Aid section, revise the statement "Solvent presents aspiration hazard" to read "Contains petroleum distillates- vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."
3. Revise your Storage and Disposal statements to be consistent with PR Notice 2001-6. Delete the statement "As a responsible...be used."
4. Under the Directions for Use section, please add the following statements to the General Instructions section of your label:

"Do not apply this product in occupied patient rooms or in any rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply in classrooms when in use. Do not apply to institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.) in the immediate area when occupants are present."

5. Under the Directions for Use, either delete the phrases "Repeat as necessary" [or Repeat as need(ed) and Repeat treatments when necessary] or indicate a time period based on the residual efficacy of your product.
6. Correct the spelling of the word "moist" in the phrase "Spray surfaces until mosit" and revise it to read "Spray surfaces until moist but not to the point of runoff."
7. Under the Flea and Tick section, add the following "Also, treat your yard with a product registered for flea and tick control."
8. Please indicate how many weeks your product will be effective against the listed pests on the label.

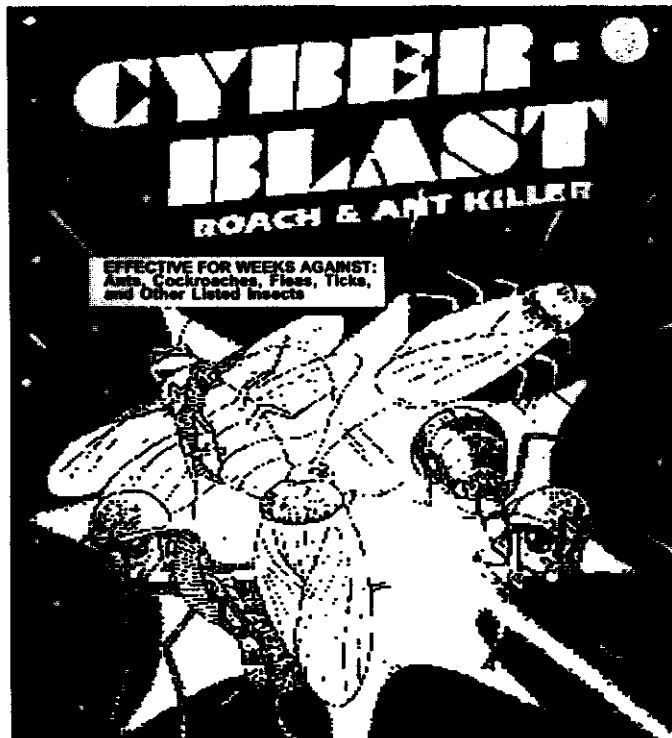

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs with this product. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:** Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control Roaches, Fleas, Silverfish, Ticks, Waterbugs, and other insects listed below. Apply as a crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until moist. Repeat as need. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. **Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation.** Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and food utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

**Non-food/feed areas** are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains, (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning and bottling).

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT:** To Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing, and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor, and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Pets should be treated with an EPA registered Flea and Tick Control product prior to re-entering treated areas.

**FOR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT:** To Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders, apply the spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids, and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs, and bases where these insects hide. Care should be taken indoors to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food handling surfaces.

**As a Residual Spray outdoors for Flies and Mosquitoes:** Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios, and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and Mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatments when necessary. 09-25-03.

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
