The following requirements or revisions apply to the label which was accepted with this registration notice:

1. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 45387-16. This registration is being issued with the understanding that the derivative of cyanuric acid which is contained in this product is under scrutiny for potential adverse effects to human. There may be some regulatory actions directed against all registered products containing this chemical as an active ingredient at some time in the future.
2. The labels which will be used for this product in channels of trade must reflect these revisions.
3. Two copies of the finished printed labels, as defined in the A-79 enclosure, must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982.
4. The finished printed labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. If the label does not satisfy these requirements it will be rejected.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is effective as a pool water disinfecting agent when used as directed. It is recommended that the pool be stabilized with cyanuric acid stabilizer to nullify the dissipation effect of sunlight on chlorine. When using this product, both chlorine and cyanuric acid stabilizer are being added to the water, however, it is necessary to initially stabilize pools with cyanuric acid to effectively maintain the desired concentration of stabilizer. Follow the directions on the label for that product.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

The filter system should be backwashed or properly cleaned and the pH adjusted between 7.2 and 7.6. Before using this product, it is necessary that the pool be super-chlorinated so that a free chlorine residual of between 1.0 and 3.0 ppm is obtained.

These sticks may be used in various type skimmers, floaters, proportioning mechanisms or feeders. Adjust whatever feeding mechanism that might be used to assure consistent treatment level of 1.0 to 2.0 ppm free available chlorine in the pool water (normally 1-2 ozs. of this product per 10,000 gallons daily.)

The regular use of a free chlorine test kit will determine if further adjustment may be necessary to maintain the recommended level of free available chlorine in the pool water.

A shock treatment should be made every week during hot weather or after heavy rain. Less frequent shock treatments may be made during cool weather. For the shock treatment, add treatment product according to the label directions for that product. Swimmers should not be permitted in the pool after the shock treatment until the chlorine residual is below 3.0 ppm.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER:** Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT—FIRST AID:** If swallowed, feed bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oil. Call physician immediately. **PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT:** Strong Oxidizing Agent: Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of heat, liberations of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed. Store in a dry place. Do not allow water to get into container. Keep container off wet floors. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**DISPOSAL:** Wastes of this pesticide may cause irreversible eye damage and burns to skin and may be dangerous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional office for guidance.
