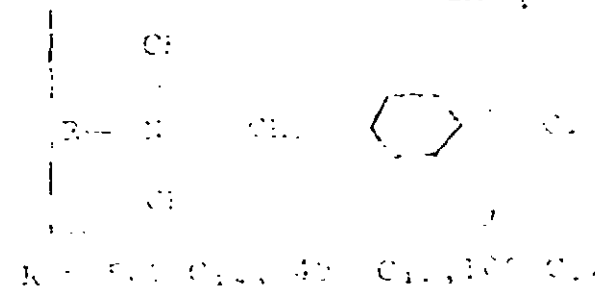

General Properties

Jordaguard 350 is soluble with water, methanol, ethanol, isopropanol, glycerols, glycols and acetone. It is insoluble in non-polar solvents, animal, vegetable and mineral oils.

Jordaguard 350 is compatible with other cationics, amphoteries at the proper pH range, nonionics, and amine oxides. These would include the Jordaine series of betaines and the Jordaron series of amine oxides.

Jordaguard 350 is generally compatible with alkaline or acid inorganics such as potassium or sodium hydroxide, carbonates, bicarbonates, phosphates, pyrophosphates, sodium nitrite, most mineral and organic acids.

Jordaguard 350 is not compatible with some sulfated oils or anionic surfactants.

The suitability of a particular additive to be included should be confirmed by biological examination. The presence of physical compatibility does not necessarily imply biological compatibility.

At use dilution, Jordaguard 350 is non-corrosive to most plastics, natural rubber and stainless steel. Solutions may be corrosive to iron, brass, aluminum, lead and tin.

REGISTRATION

All products used on inanimate surfaces which are sold and claimed to be bacteriostatic, germicidal, algacidal or to kill or inhibit organisms in any way are required to be registered with the Environmental Protection Agency.

Most states also have similar requirements for registration of such products.

SAFETY AND HANDLING

DANGER: Corrosive. Keep out of reach of children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid inhalation. Painful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of fluid and call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DRUM DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen cling particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.
