Your submission dated June 29, 2001

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. In the Ingredients Statement, the words "OTHER INGREDIENTS" should be in the same type size and style as the words "ACTIVE INGREDIENT".
 - b. The Agency notes that you no longer specify the types of non-bearing fruit trees (citrus and peach) and vines (kiwi and grape) that had appeared on the previous labeling. You may want to specify these plants somewhere in the Directions for Use.
3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The Basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 29, 2001 which identifies a replacement diazinon source Manufacturing Use Product is acceptable and has been added to this product's registration file. Please submit or have your supplier submit directly to the Agency the upper certified limits for the diazinon impurities of toxicological concern (i.e., TEPP, O,S TEPP, S,S TEPP, and oxodiazinon) which you refer to in your Certification Statement associated with the CSF.

Insecticide - Insulator

To be used as a trunk wrap for non-bearing fruit trees and vines for protection from damage by ants and from freezing.

Read Carefully and Follow All Label Directions When Using This Product.

Directions for Use:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with this labeling. Reformulation or repackaging of this product is prohibited.

1. Clear soil away from base of tree well below bud union.
2. Clip off sprouts and thorns to 14 inches above the ground.
3. Place the two halves of the **Clip-On** around the trunk with the packet of insect powder toward the bottom. **Do not puncture the bag or flasks.**
4. Adjust for best fit making sure that the mating faces of the two halves are tightly together and top is snug to the tree.
5. Slip the spring clip on just above the center of the **Clip-on** such that the two ends press against the flat sides of the insulator.
6. The CLIP-ON must be removed from the tree or vine 1 year before they reach the bearing stage.
