1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete the word "milk."
 - b. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for the appropriate Storage and Disposal statements.
 - c. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" directly above the signal word "Danger."
 - d. A contact time of at least 60 seconds is required for sanitization.
2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula is acceptable.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


