

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (& Domestic Animals)
DANGER

- Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid breathing vapor. Keep container closed and with adequate ventilation. Wash thoroughly after handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID: For eye contact hold eyelids apart and flush with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. For skin contact flush with large amounts of running water for 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if skin irritation occurs. Wash clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Immediately give large quantities of water. If vomiting does occur, give fluids again. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or the nearest poison control center immediately.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. Get medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs.

SPILL OR LEAK: Flush spill area with water. Observe local, state, and federal laws and regulations regarding disposal, spill cleanup, removal, or discharge.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open burning is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide sprays that do not rinse, that are not to be used, or when they are processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Dispose of this container in a landfill approved for pesticides. Containers may be reused in a safe place.

1. Immediately after use, rinse equipment with clear water.

5. Just before use, prepare a solution of fluid ounce CLENESCO ARC to six gallons of water to provide 200 ppm dodecylbenzenesulfonic acid. Sanitize equipment by wiping or scrubbing using the preparation.
6. After sanitizing, rinse all equipment with cleanable water before re-use.
