CONTROL OF TADPOLE SHRIMP IN FLOODED RICE FIELDS. Blue Viking Copper Sulfate is recommended for the control of tadpole shrimp in rice fields. Blue Viking should be applied at a rate of 10 to 15 pounds per acre by mixing with 550 perts of water and applying as a uniform surface spray using boat and pressurface spraying device. Use at the first Indication of in featation after the field has been flooded to a depth of 8 to 8 inches Blue Viking is especially graded for maximum solubility in this volume of water.

Blue Viking Copper Sulfate kills Filamentous and Plankton algae in flooded rice fields, take or pond water at 0.27 ppm to 0.54 ppm (Cur. in the treated water. Apply at a rate of 3 to 6 pounds per acre foot of water. Mix Blue Viking with 100 parts of water and apply the minimum as a uniform sulface apray using boot and pressurtand apraying device. Apply twice yearly—as needed. Determine the number of acre feet of water to be treated. An acre foot of water is equal to one acre of water one foot deep which equals 328,000 gallons or 2.720,000 pounds.

SEWER TREATMENT-ROOT DESTROYER

- A For Partial Stoppage Add 13 pound of Bise Viking to sewer at drain and flush toward blackage with 5 gallons of water. Repeal at 6 month intervals to prevent growth of new

WOOD TREATMENT (green peeled posts) — fungus decay, rol.

Prepare a solution of 18.0 pounds of sodium chromate in each 26 gallons of water to be used and a separate second solution of 18.0 pounds of copper sulfate in each 24 gallons of water to be used, soak the peeled green posts, buttlend down first in the copper sulfate solution for 3 days then buttlend down in the sodium chromate solution for 2 days, and finally, turn the posts upside down in the sadium chremate solution for 1 additional day, ramove and rinse posts with clear

BORDEAUX MIXTURE

HOW TO UNDERSTAND BORDEAUX FORMULATIONS:

If the Bordeaux Mixture instructions reed 10-10-100, the first figure means the number of pounds of copper sulfate pentahydrate. The second figure means the pounds of hydrated spray inne, and the third figure, the gallons of water to be used. Use as a full coverage spray to runoff.

HOW TO PREPARE A BORDEAUX MIXTURE:

To propers a Bordeaux mixture, fill a tank with water, one-quarter full. Then with an agitator running, mix in Blue Viking Star Copper Sulfate through a copper, bronze, stulniess steel or plastic screen. Add water so the tank is three-quarters full. Mix in the hydrated spray lime through the screen, and finish filling the tank with water.
