

This product is designed to dissolve allowly (3-7 days) providing a steady source of available chlorine in swimming pools to control the growth of signs, kill becteris, and destroy organic contaminants.

Use a floating dispenser, sutomatic chicrinator or feeder designed for

this product, or place in akimmer.

• Use in a new chlorinating device or any device which has previously contained only this product or whose active ingredient is tricipro-s-triezinetrione. If placed in the skimmer, run the pump a minimum of

eight hours daily.

DO NOT reuse floaters or feeders from other dry chlorinating products. DO NOT permit tablets to contact plastic pool linings or metal objects.

water, because: To provide optimum product performence, awimmer comfort and crystal clear water, always maintain pH from 7.2 to 7.8, total alkalinity from 90 to 125 ppm, and calcium hardness above 200 ppm. Test frequently using a reliable test kit or strips that measures all these ranges. Make any necessary adjustments promptly with the appropriate products.

ROUTINE CHLORINATION: Every Week (or as needed):
Add four 1/2 ounce tablets for each 10,000 gallons of pool water to
maintain chlorine residuel at 1-3ppm. Follow "Mathod Of Application". This decage may vary depending upon bather load, water temperature and other conditions. Pool should not be entered until the chlorine realdual is 1-3 ppm. se measured with a reliable test kit or strip. SHOCK TREATMENT:
Adjust pit to 7.2 to 7.4 with many appropriate product per label instructions.
Shock brast weekly with Maintain Shock Treatment or Maintain Liquid
Shock to kill becateria, control algae, burn out organic materials and to keep water sparkfuling clear. Police table the rections.
