On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 45458-18."

b. In the ingredients statement on the label, change the letter "S" (between "Trichloro" and "triazinetrione") to the lower-case "s".

c. Change the "Active Ingredients" heading to the singular "Active Ingredient", and align it to the same left margin with "Inert Ingredients".

d. In the Available Chlorine statement, reposition the "89%" so that it is not lined up directly under the percentages of active and inert ingredients.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not handle with bare hands. Wear goggles or face shield and use rubber gloves and only thoroughly clean, dry utensils when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust and fumes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID: (PRACTICAL TREATMENT). If Swallowed: Drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Do not use this product in any chlorinating device which has been used with any inorganic or unstabilized chlorinating compounds (e.g. calcium hypochlorite). Such use may cause fire or explosion. Do not permit tablets to contact plastic pool linings or metal objects. Do not throw tablets directly into pool.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD: This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate lakes, ponds or streams by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
EMERGENCY HANDLING: In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reuse container. If possible, isolate container in open and well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water. Dispose of contaminated material in an approved landfill area.

- Startup:
1. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.4 with Maintain pH
 2. Superchlorinate with "Maintain Shock Treatment" residual. Follow label directions.
 3. The next day stabilize your pool using directions.

Routine Care: Add one 7 ounce tablet to dry, or as needed to maintain chlorine residual. Maintain pH between 7.2-7.6 and calcium hardness above 200 ppm. Test adjustments with the appropriate pool test kit. "Maintain Shock Treatment" to burn sparkling clear.

In case of algae, colored water, unpleasant heavy rains and winds, or high temperature "Shock Treatment." Follow label directions in the skimmer for each 10,000 gallons are discolored. If algae are visible, do treatment the following day if necessary: is 1-3 ppm.
