**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER:** Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not handle with bare hands. Wear goggles or face shield and use rubber gloves and only thoroughly clean, dry utensils when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust and fumes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**FIRST AID: (PRACTICAL TREATMENT).** If Swallowed: Drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Do not use this product in any chlorinating device which has been used with any inorganic or unstabilized chlorinating compounds (e.g. calcium hypochlorite). Such use may cause fire or explosion. Do not permit sticks to contact plastic pool linings or metal objects. Do not throw sticks directly into pool.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**  
Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.  
**EMERGENCY HANDLING:** In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reuse container. If possible, isolate container in open and well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water. Dispose of contaminated material in an approved landfill area.

## CONCENTRATED POOL CHLORINATING STICKS

Net Wt. 8 Lbs.

Directions for Pool Chlorination:  
Inconsistent with instructions. Designed to dissolve chlorine to control algae.

For Best Results: Place in a floating dispenser. Rinse linings or metal objects until sticks are dissolved.

- Start Up:
1. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.6.
  2. Superchlorinate with 10% residual. Follow instructions.
  3. The next day stabilize with 1% residual.

**Routine Care:** Add 1 stick per 10,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days, or as needed to maintain a residual of 1%. Tablets are dissolved in the skimmer. Adjust calcium hardness or alkalinity with the "Maintain Shock Treatment" product. Sparkling clear.

In case of algae, color, or cloudy water, use "Shock Treatment." Follow instructions. In the skimmer for 24 hours. If algae or color is still present, use the following day if necessary.

To Determine Pool Capacity:  
RECTANGULAR—Multiply length by width by depth.  
ROUND—Multiply diameter by diameter by depth.  
OVAL—Multiply length by width by depth.
