The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1
- Update mandatory and advisory labeling per PR Notice 2000-5
- Update Disposal instructions per PR Notice 2001-6

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

Separate the Precautionary Statement heading from the First Aid Statements. In addition, the precautionary heading and its statement must be grouped together to 1. read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

- 2. It is preferred that the child signal word "Caution" and the "Keep out of Reach of Children" statement be placed under the ingredient statement.
- 3. Revise the statement "require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water." to read "Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water." to agree with the last stamped label dated December 20, 1988.
