For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one ounce of this product per 2500 gallons of water. For each 2500 gallons of water, add 1.0 ounce of this product by weight.
Maintenance:
A. Adjust pool water pH to the range 7.4-7.6 and maintain.
B. Add this product by 4 level scoops per 2500 gallons of water. Do not add more than 1.0 ounce of this product per 2500 gallons of water. Frequency of addition will vary with pool temperature and bather load. For maintenance, add 1/2 level scoop per 2500 gallons of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS

1. Stop water flow to the well. 2. Turn on the pump. 3. Add 1/2 level scoop of this product to the well. 4. Run the pump for 15 minutes. 5. Turn off the pump. 6. Draw water from the well. 7.
