#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER:** Corrosive, causes irreversible eye damage and causes skin damage. Harmful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. This product is a potential skin sensitizer. Workmen handling this product or treated material should wear impervious gloves, goggles or face shield, and protective clothing. All protective clothing, work shoes or boots, and equipment must be left at the work site at the end of the day. Eating, drinking, or smoking during use of this product is prohibited.

**COOLING TOWERS:** Wemcide CW 115 is used to protect rot and internal or dry rot. It is applied by spraying or painting weight Wemcide CW 115 in water onto the clean wood surface. Apply 0.6 to 0.8 lb. Wemcide CW 115 per 1000 ft.<sup>2</sup> of wood surface by periodic shock doses of Wemcide CW 115 to the recirculating cold well. The dosage should provide 1.25 lb. of Wemcide bleedoff should be stopped for 4 to 6 hr. after treatment. Repeat every four months.

**COOLING WATER:** Wemcide CW 115 is used to control circulating cooling water systems. Before treatment is begun to remove old algal growth, microbiological slime, and drained, flushed, refilled with water, and treated with an i CW 115 per 1000 gal. water in the system. Subsequent should be made every 1 to 5 days, depending on amount fouling.

**DRILLING FLUIDS:** To inhibit bacterial and fungal degradation of wells, Wemcide CW 115 is incorporated in the drilling fluid based on the total wet weight of the fluid.

**PETROLEUM SECONDARY RECOVERY:** Wemcide CW 115 controls bacteria, slime-forming bacteria and fungi in oil-field water disposal systems, and other oil-field water systems at disposal. CW 115 per 1000 gal. of water treated. Additions should be made by means of a metering pump at the free water knockouts, before well headers. Continuous Feed Method: When system is treated with Wemcide CW 115 per 1000 gal. of water continuously use. Then treat with 1.2 to 2.0 fl. oz. Wemcide CW 115 per 100 to maintain control. Intermittent or Slug Method: When to maintain control, add 1.2 to 4.0 fl. oz. Wemcide CW 115 per 10 to 4 times per week, or as needed to maintain control.

**CRUDE AND REFINED OILS:** Wemcide CW 115 is an bacteria and fungi that cause the degradation of crude oil. It should be added to the oil as it is being transferred from the tank at the rate of 0.6 to 6.0 fl. oz. Wemcide CW 115 per 1000 gal. where mixing occurs or continuously to the suction side of the pump.

### STORAGE & DIS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not store in well-ventilated areas.
