A C W - 15 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming poot3, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness poots, spas, whitpoits, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using A C W. $\mathbf{1 5}$.
For pools having just visible algae growth ajd an initial dose of 50 to 77 thid ounces of A C W - 15 per 10,000 galions of water and remove settiod algas debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pcol add initistly 27 to 50 thuid ounces of A CW - 15 per 10,000 gallcns of water. Subsequent additions of 9 to 13 fluid ounces of A C W- 15 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatmant for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth ,:qure an initial dose of 5 to 8 fluid ounces of A C W- 15 per 1000 gallons of water. F t.eatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially 3 to 5 fh: ? . $n$ nces of A C W - 15 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 is 2 fluid on . $s$ of A C W - 15 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial traatment for maintenance.

A CW - 15 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat poots and spas end is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. A C W - 15 can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix ACW- 16 with concentrgited dry or liquid chiorine products.

STORAGE 5 DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, foord, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Rinsate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buriod in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.
$\square$ METAL CONTAINERS: Triple rinse and offer for recyciing, seconditioning, or disposal in an approved landtill or bury in a safe place.

PLASTIC CONTAINEIS: Do not reuse empty container. Tripie tinse and incinerate or dispose of in an approved landfill or bury in safe place.
