SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Do not use this product on manhole covers in storm drain systems

Application Restrictions

Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. Do not allow spray to drift from the application site and contact people, structures people occupy at any time and the associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals, The applicator also must use all other measures to control drift.
