Amended labeling to revise the container handling (i.e., cleaning) instructions

Product Name: Insecta® EPA Reg. No. 45600-1 EPA Decision No. 461249

The proposed labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable with the following comment:

• At the end of the Container Handling section, add the following text: "Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn unless allowed by state and local ordinances." (This language appeared on the previously approved label, and appears to have been inadvertently deleted).

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself. This information can be added by non-notification per PR Notice 98-10.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
