The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Chlorpyrifos 2022 Biological Opinion and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. The next label printing of this product must use this labeling unless subsequent changes have been approved. In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of

For use ONLY in enclosed sanitary sewer systems It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent

with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or bystanders, either directly or through drift.

Do not use this product in manholes in storm drain systems.

Kills cockroaches in sewer manholes for up to one year when exposed to treated, painted surfaces.

### **Environmental Hazards**

This product is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, small mammals and birds. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water or rinsate. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treated areas.

#### Storage and Disposal

Manholes: Apply product only on manhole walls. Product is to applied via coarse spray using conventional airless spray equ ment delivered through a 6 foot (or longer) spray wand with m mum of 2 spray tips (for even application). The application Insecta to sewer manhole walls must be applied only from abo ground and the applicator is not to enter the manhole. Apply more than 48 ounces (3 pints) of product to each manhole. Do discharge spray or unused material directly into sewer system. not apply product within 36 hours of predicted heavy rainfall.

ATTENTION: Dries guickly and rinses easily with water. Allow dry for several days before washing. As contact between insect and the treated surface is necessary, any time that latter becomes coated with dust or dirt, the treated surface sho be washed with water in order to re-establish maximum possi contact. INSECTA applied on exposed glass, glazed tile, metal other non-porous surfaces may dry leaving a light film.
