IMPORTANT - Hold container in upright position to spray. Shake well. Hold container about 6 to 12 inches from surface being sprayed, spraying at a rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet.

If applied in home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils or wash thoroughly before reuse. Cover exposed food. Do not apply to surfaces which actually contact food during preparation or wangers, feed troughs and milkrooms.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: (Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served) including, but not limited to bars, restaurants, food stores, bakeries, bottling plants, canneries and grain mills.
