How To Apply The Insecta[®] System.

Insecta[®] is also available in liquid form.

Kills roaches, ants, spiders, flies mosquitoes, Palmetto bugs, fire ants, scorpions, black widow spiders, earwigs, silverfish by contact as a surface spray with residual action.

Apply a barrier of insecta in areas such as baseboards, around pipes, under cabinets and sinks and help keep your home insect-free. See enclosed brochure for complete instructions.

Directions For Use.

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Important: Hold container in upright position to spray. Shake well. Hold container about 6 to 12 inches from surface being sprayed, spraying at a rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet.

Apply the coating in cracks and crevices, on baseboards, underneath kitchen and bathroom shelves and sinks, behind refrigerators, around points of entry such as windows and door sills in homes, apartments, offices, hotels, motels, restaurants.

If applied in home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils or wash thoroughly before reuse. Cover exposed food. Do not apply to surfaces which actually contact food during preparation.

Precautionary Statements.

Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

Caution: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Keep children and pets away from surface until spray is dry.

Statement of Practical Treatment.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on skin or clothing: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If inhaled: Remove to fresh air if effects occur, and call a physician.

If swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

Note to physician: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote.

Environmental Hazards: This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.

Chemical and Physical Hazards: Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees F. may cause bursting.

Storage and Disposal.

Storage: Store away from heat or open flames in an area inaccessible to children.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
