Dear Mr. Quinlan:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision.

1) Insert the sentence shown in italics below into the Directions for Use section on the label.

Do not apply sprays of this product inside conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment where a possible shock hazard exists.

While reviewing your label, I also noted that the first page states the words "around windows...doors" twice. Treatment as a crack and crevice and spot treatment around windows and doors, both internally and externally, is now a registered use of this product. However, I suspect that the first "windows and doors" phrase is meant to refer to internal treatment while the second "windows, doors" is meant to refer to external treatment.

If you so choose, you may clarify your intentions by modifying the second phrase to read something akin to "around external window and door frames." You may do this by notification to the Agency. Please reference this letter if you submit such a notification.

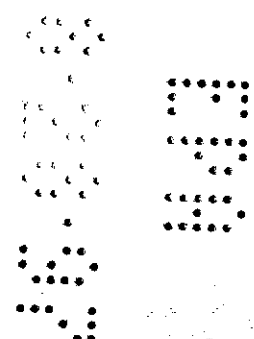
Apply as a crack and crevice and spot treatment on non-food contact surfaces around points of entry including underneath the sink, in back of stoves and refrigerators, on and along baseboards, around windows and doors, back of cabinets and desks in homes, apartments, offices, warehouses, hospitals, hotels, motels, schools, restaurants, theaters, animal hospitals, kennels and as a barrier on foundations, eaves, around windows, doors, utility installations including electrical transformer boxes and other insect entry locations.

How To Apply Insecta

Kills roaches, ants, spiders, flies, mosquitoes, millipedes, ticks, gnats, palmetto bugs, silverfish, earwigs, crickets, fire ants, scorpions and black widow spiders by contact as a surface spray with residual action.

Apply a barrier of Insecta as a crack and crevice and spot treatment and help keep your home insect-free.

Insecta is also available in liquid form.

Directions For Use


It is a violation of Federal Law to use this label in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Important: Shake well prior to use. Wear rubberized gloves during application. Hold container between 6 and 12 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray at a rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet. Do not spray directly on plants, shrubs or grass.

If applied in home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils or wash thoroughly before reuse. Cover exposed food. Do not apply to surfaces which actually contact food during preparation.

Food Handling Establishments: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served including, but not limited to bars, restaurants, food stores, bakeries, bottling plants, canneries and grain mills. Application shall be limited to crack and crevice treatment. For crack and crevice treatment, this product's nozzle is capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide. Prior to application, de-energize equipment and allow time for solvent to evaporate before starting motors or placing in "ON" position. Do not apply INSECTA on or near flames or heated surfaces.

Food Must Be Removed Or Covered During Treatment: Insecta aids in the control of pantry pests in and around both food and non-food areas. Apply INSECTA to localized areas where these pests have been seen or are suspected of hiding or entering. Apply only enough to wet the surface. Avoid runoff. Do not allow the insecticide to contact food or food processing surfaces. Areas to be treated include along baseboards and moldings, around plumbing and other utility installations, dark corners and closets, and around doors, ventilators and windows. Apply adjacent to tin paneling or other material loosely attached to walls. Floor drains, garbage rooms and locker rooms should be included in treatment. Treated surfaces should not be washed or cleaned for 36 hours after application.

Attention: As contact between the insects and the coated surface is necessary, any time that the latter becomes covered with dust or dirt, the coated surface should be washed with water in order to reestablish maximum possible contact. INSECTA applied on exposed glass, glazed tile, metal or other non-porous surfaces may dry leaving a light film.

Precautionary Statements
Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals
CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Keep children and pets away from surface until spray is dry.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

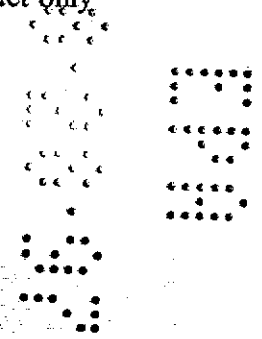
If on skin or clothing: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

Note to Physician: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters. Do not apply directly to water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Chemical and Physical Hazards
