3. A one year storage stability study for this product must be submitted within 18 months from the date of this registration.

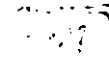
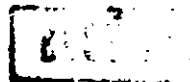
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

All loose paint, whitewash, dirt, mildew, oil and other contaminants must be removed to insure a clean surface. This product is supplied ready to use after stirring thoroughly. For interior home use, this product should be applied by brush or rolled on target areas as stated on the front part of this label in the form of a band a few inches in width to obtain an even coat covering approximately 425 s.f. per gallon. For uses other than interior home application, apply with brush, roller or spray. Wash brush, roller or spraying equipment thoroughly with soap and water after use. As contact between the insect and coated surface is necessary, any time that the latter becomes covered with dust or dirt, the coated surface should be washed with clear water in order to re-establish maximum possible contact.
