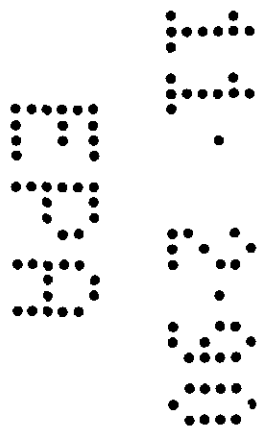

DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT Hold container in upright position to spray. Shake well. Hold container about 6 to 12 inches from surface being sprayed, spraying at a rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet.

Apply the coating in cracks and crevices, on baseboards, underneath kitchen and bathroom shelves and sinks, behind refrigerators, around points of entry, such as window and door sills.

If applied in home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils or wash thoroughly before reuse. Cover exposed food. Do not apply to surfaces which actually contact food during preparation, or mangers, feed troughs and milkrooms.

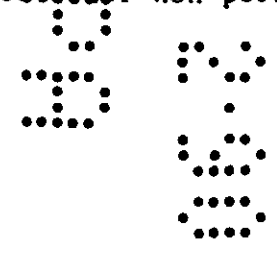
FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: (Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served) including, but not limited to bars, restaurants, food stores, bakeries, bottling plants, canneries and grain mills. Application shall be limited to spot treatment and/or crack and crevice treatment.

FOOD MUST BE REMOVED OR COVERED DURING TREATMENT

SPOT APPLICATION controls cockroaches, ants, crickets, silverfish and spiders and aids in the control of pantry pests in and around both food and non-food areas. Apply INSECTA to localized areas where these pests have been seen or are suspected of hiding and entering. Apply only enough to wet the surface. Avoid runoff. Do not allow the insecticide to contact food or food processing surfaces. Areas to be treated include baseboards, moldings, around plumbing and other utility installations, dark corners and closets, and around doors, ventilators, windows and other openings. Apply adjacent to tin panelling or other material loosely attached to walls. Completely band the undersides of work tables and storage shelving but never on the exposed work-storage surface. Remove all drawers and band the three exterior sides but never the interior or front. Floor drains, garbage rooms and locker rooms should be included in treatment. Treated surfaces should not be washed or cleaned for 36 hours after application.

CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT: should be made by applying INSECTA directly into openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases or at points that occur between different elements of construction or especially where equipment joins floors and walls. Prior to application de-energize equipment and allow time for solvent to evaporate before starting motors or placing in "ON" position. Do not apply INSECTA on or near flames or heated surfaces.

Caution: INSECTA covers approximately 100 sq. ft. per 9 oz. cans. Dries quickly. Allow to dry for several days before washing. As contact between the insect and the coated surface is necessary, any time that the latter becomes covered with dust or dirt, the coated surface should be washed with water in order to re-establish maximum possible contact. INSECTA applied on exposed glass, glazed tile, metal, or other non-porous surfaces may dry leaving a light film.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Keep children and pets away from surface until spray is dry.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air if effects occur, and call a physician.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters.

CHEMICAL AND PHYSICAL HAZARDS:

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees F. may cause bursting.

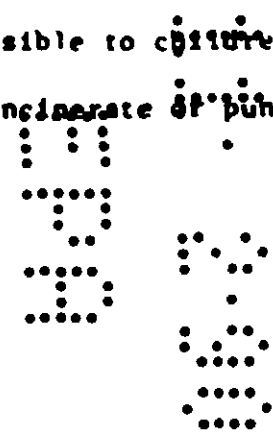
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
